# Manche territory : a life-size playground

Life-size playground, La Manche, regularly hosts major international events: the endurance event of the 2014 World Equestrian Games in the Bay of Mont-Saint-Michel and the Horse-ball event being demonstrated in the horse club of Saint-Lô. This site is a stronghold of sports competition as attested by the 100,000 spectators welcomed each year, including more than 25,000 on the Normandy Horse Show.

The 360 kilometers of coast offer an exceptional reception area for many important events. Each year, the Channel hosts a stage of the Tour de France sailing and in 2018, the World University Championship was held for a week.

Traditionally acquired in cycling, the Channel has had the opportunity to host in 2013 a stage against the clock of the Tour de France and, in 2016, the grand start of the Tour de France has met an incredible craze and know-how. Strong place of the French Cyclo-cross, Flamanville will receive, on January 11 and 12, 2020, the championships of France having regularly hosted since 2013 the Coupe de France.

The Channel is also a land of top-level athletes with titles such as world champions in riding Eric Levallois and Reynald Angot, in kayak-polo Maxime Gohier (triple champion) and Yves-Marie Denis, Benoît Cosnefroy in cycling (champion of hopeful world in 2017) and Eric Delaunay, 7th in the last Olympic Games, world and European champion. ## Cité des Sports complex

The Cité des Sports sports complex, which opened in 2008, is less than 3 hours 30 minutes from Paris. It is a modern facility open to all users. With various rooms (3 gymnasiums, 1 gym, a boxing studio, a dojo and a dance studio) plus additional spaces (meeting room, team leader's office, storage facility, etc.), it is the ideal place for Olympic and Paralympic athletes to prepare for competition. The complex is 300 metres from the coast and less than a 15-minute walk from Granville town centre. The recently opened aquatic centre is also located at the Cité des Sports.

## **Regional Climbing Centre**








## Saint-Lô equestrian centre

The 35-hectare equestrian centre is situated in the centre of Saint Lô (Manche/Normandy). The facilities include the former Haras National (built by Napoleon I in the late 19th century), plus an indoor hall (capacity: 3,000), 8 arenas, 4 riding rings and 471 stables. The centre plays host to events for 160 days each year, including innovative events and activities to support the equestrian sector and professionals, and riding competitions. In addition to centre management activities, the centre branches out into other activities to promote its historic heritage.


