### **UFR STAPS Gymnastics Centre**

The UFR STAPS Gymnastics Centre is located on the Mont-Saint-Aignan campus, 10 minutes from the centre of Rouen. The centre includes a gym, 2 gymnasiums (type C), 2 dance studios with wooden flooring, a dojo and a 150-capacity amphitheatre, all interconnected. The gymnastics room has 4 cameras linked to 4 screens, providing different angles of view during training in each area. Most of the gymnastics equipment is Gymnova-branded with



short ropes, and there are two pieces of most items of equipment. There is one latest-generation Janssen floor. The room has lead ropes above the asymmetric bars and fixed bar, a long elasticated rope for the rings, a horizontal lead rope on the acrobatic, and a 4-piece lead rope on the large trampoline.

### Stéphane Diagana Gymnasium

The Stéphane Diagana Gymnasium is located in the centre of Pont-Audemer, in an idyllic rural setting yet just 10 minutes from the nearby motorway network, with links to Paris in 1 hour 30 minutes, Le Havre in 40 minutes, Rouen in 30 minutes, and Caen in 45 minutes. The climbing room, which opened in 2007, is a modern facility open to all users. With various additional spaces (team leader's office, storage facility, gym, boulders, etc.), it is the ideal place for Olympic and Paralympic athletes to prepare for competition.

The complex, located 2 hours 30 minutes from Paris, 10 minutes from the centre of Le Havre and 15 minutes from the coast, is home to France's oldest rowing club. ## **The Alain Guilloit Aquatic Centre**

The Alain Guilloit Aquatic Centre is situated close to the motorway, just 1 hour 40 minutes from central Paris. The centre boasts a number of pools, including a 50-metre outdoor pool that has been used a training venue by several Olympic champions including Hugues Duboscq and David Abrahard. There are also pools of other sizes and depths for specific activities, plus two gyms including one dedicated cardio room and a separate weight room. There is also a jacuzzi, sauna and solarium for athletes to recover.


